Today banks offer 24 X 7 cash withdrawal and cash deposit services at their branches through CRMs, while at offsite (non-branch) locations, banks mostly offer only 24 X 7 cash withdrawal services through ATMs. The Upgradable ATM, will allow banks to safeguard their investment and expand their services to include cash deposit facility at offsite locations, at a later stage, based on their business needs and local market conditions.

Providing an efficient way to upgrade ATM to CRM, this innovative offering eliminates the need for expensive replacements and lengthy installation processes while enabling banks to be future-ready for evolving market requirements. The company is also aligned with the recent monetary policy announcement by Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to enable UPI for cash deposit facility, as its new-age solution is designed to support UPI based cash withdrawal and cash deposit.
